# OPTIONS

## **Sponsorship:**

This option is for a company or individual who is interested in simply sponsoring one of the 20 areas set aside for sponsorship or adoption. This would require a donation once a year, typically at the end of the year for the amount indicated.

## **Adoption:**

This option is for a company or individual that would be interested in sponsoring one of the 20 areas set aside and would also be interested in being physically involved in remodeling the area of the base that they have adopted.

They would schedule and send a group of 6 or less on a trip to Costa Rica. The trip would be for one week and would include 4 days of work at the base, one day of vacation, and some experience in hands on missions. The costs for this trip would be covered by a \$500 yearly donation in addition to the sponsorship. The individual would be responsible for their own airfare to and from Costa Rica.

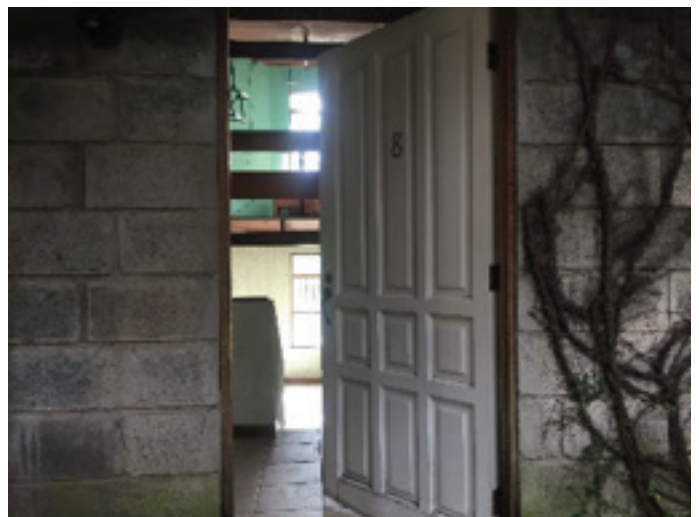
## Cabin 8

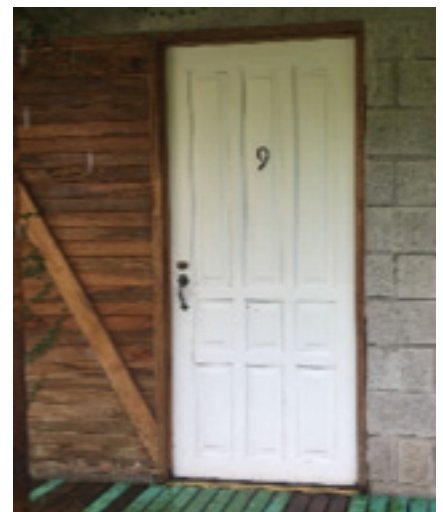


## Cabin 9

Several months ago a tree limb broke off during a wind storm and destroyed a good portion of this room. What was destroyed was mainly wood structure. The goal is to rebuild this room to hold 10 bunk beds for short term teams.

**Cost:** \$4,000

## Meeting/Teaching Classroom

**Use:** Meeting Area

**Description:**

Teaching and gathering together is at the heart of what we do in discipleship. This room will serve for our Vida220 classes, Vida Missions training sessions, and staff chapel activities. It is a large spacious room with a fireplace to one side. It can seat up to 30 students for training at tables or 100 in individual chairs.

**Cost:** \$5,000



## VidaNet Offices

**Use:** Offices

**Description:**

This area is where VidaNet will have offices. There is a large entrance area that will double as a conference room and an office for the ministry manager and the program directors

**Cost:** \$4,000



## **Relationship Room (discipleship room)**

**Use:** games, relaxing, conversation

### **Description:**

At VidaNet our goal and passion is discipleship and you will often hear us say "discipleship happens at the speed of relationship." That is why this room is at the heart of our base. It has several comfortable sofas, a chimney, a bar, and a lower level where someone started to build a sauna that would work perfectly as a library and prayer rooms. It is a very warm and inviting space that will be very important to us as a ministry.

**Cost:** \$4,000



## Utility Building

**Use:** Laundry, shop, storage, staff family housing

**Description:**

This building serves as a utility building for the base. It houses: (to the left) a laundry, storage area for ministry items, and (to the right) a workshop for maintenance on our base as well as our fleet of vehicles. In the center is a house that will be remodeled to function as housing for a staff family or as a permanent living space for the Casa242 ministry of VidaNet.

**Cost:** \$4,000
